What is the 10/40 Window? The 10/40 Window is the area of the world that is 10 degrees south to 40 degrees north of the equator and extends all the way from western Africa to eastern Asia. It includes North Africa, the Middle East, Asia, and some parts of Europe.

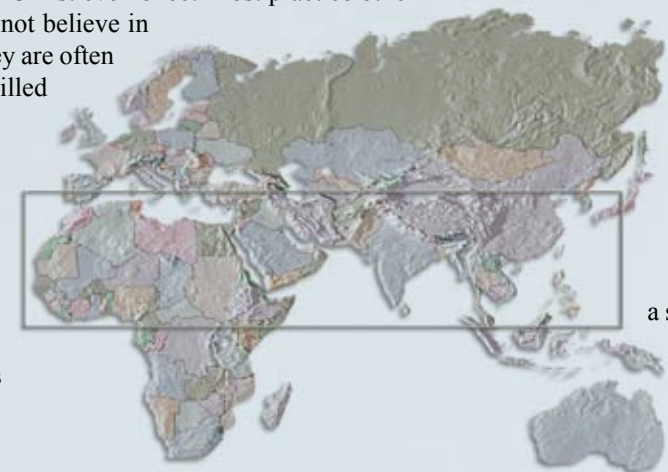
Many children in the Window have never heard about our Lord Jesus Christ even once! Most practice other religions such as Islam, Buddhism, Hinduism, tribal religions, or do not believe in any God at all. There are some Christians in the 10/40 Window, but they are often persecuted for their faith. They can lose their jobs, be jailed, or even killed for talking about Jesus Christ!

Why do they need prayer? Well, there are over 1.8 billion children who are 14 years old or younger in the 10/40 Window. Some are the poorest people in the world. Many are too poor to see a doctor when they are sick or to go to school to learn to read and write. They are normal children just like you, but many suffer from big problems such as abuse, homelessness, starvation, and being sold to work long hours at adult jobs. In some countries, children are even forced to be soldiers in the military!

How should I pray?

For the safety, health, and well being of the 10/40 Window children. Let's pray that:

- Jesus Christ will use the church to bring freedom to children that are forced into hard labor and slavery. (Isaiah 61:1)
- God will bring Christian helpers to provide enough food and doctors for all children to be healthy. (3 John 2)
- God will protect children from physical abuse by adults. (Matthew 18:10)
- God will be a Father to the orphans and children living on the street. (Psalm 27:10)
- God will heal the minds and bodies of children who live in war zones and those who have served as soldiers. (Psalm 107:20)
- Every child will have an opportunity to go to school. (Jeremiah 29:11)
- All children living in refugee camps will be loved and well cared for. (Philippians 3:20)
- Girl-children will be loved and treated equally as boys. (John 8:36)
- That children living in areas devastated by earthquakes, tsunamis, and war will find comfort and security in Jesus Christ. (Philippians 4:7)



For all people to learn of the love that Father God has for them. Let's pray that:

- God will open doors to the countries where the Gospel is not allowed. (Acts 26:18)
- All people in the 10/40 Window will realize their need for Jesus Christ. (John 14:6)
- God will help Christians to stand firm in their faith despite persecution, and keep them from harm. (1 Corinthians 16:13)
- Children living in wealthy countries will hunger after Jesus Christ instead of material things. (John 6:35)
- Jesus Christ will reveal Himself to children in dreams and visions and that children will lead their parents to Him. (Joel 2:28)
- God will put an end to evil practices and traditions such as chewing qat, forced circumcision, child brides, worship of Kumaris, and making offerings to their false gods. (Ephesians 1:4)
- Translators will make Bibles available in every language in the 10/40 Window. (Psalm 107:20)
